ASI's Arts Access program aims to break the barriers of inaccessibility to the arts which are often money, transportation, and knowledge of events. We partner with local theaters, galleries, and other arts and culture organizations to offer free or reduced-cost opportunities to Western New Yorkers. Eligibility is open to anyone receiving income-based public assistance in WNY. Passes are honored at our 50+ partner locations. Additionally, ASI offers free safe transportation to and from events upon request.

How to use your pass

1

Check Availability

To check if Arts Access reservations are available, please call the main office or box office of your selected venue. For general admission, call at least 48 hours in advance due to capacity limits or scheduled tours. For ticketed events, call as soon as you know about the event to confirm availability.

2

Provide Your Member ID:

When calling or visiting, provide your Arts Access member ID number shown on your pass.

3

Understand Reservation Policies:

Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. You may not always get your preferred date or event. Arts Access partners donate tickets based on their budget, typically with limited quantity.

4

Reserve Transportation (optional):

ASI provides free, safe, and accessible transportation through our partners at Hart Transportation to and from partner events. Ride reservations must be made through the Arts Access office at least 2 weeks before your event date. See details on the following page to make a reservation.

5

Stay Informed:

Always check with the partner organization for the most up-to-date information. Especially as it relates weather policy, cancellations, and postponement.

Arts Access Plus Lottery

The Arts Access program relies on the generosity of our partner organizations to donate tickets to Arts Access with very limited compensation; they are the real champions of this incredible program!

Because tickets are donated, some partner programming may not be available to Arts Access passholders. This includes; special exhibits, behind-the-scenes tours, or special guest performances.

How does it work? The Arts Access Plus Lottery provides a monthly chance to win tickets to exclusive events. Each month, ASI selects special ticketed events for the lottery. Passholders can enter the lottery for a chance to win two free tickets! ASI then purchases the tickets on the winning passholder's behalf.

Transportation

Arts Access is proud to provide free, safe, and accessible transportation through our partners at Hart Transportation to and from partner events.

To book a ride, please contact the Arts Access office directly. Kindly refrain from calling drivers or the transportation company for new requests. For transportation arrangements, call 716-833-3004 x514 or visit arts-access.org/transportation. Please note that our service operates on a scheduled basis with limited availability.

By requesting a ride, you agree to adhere to our code of conduct.

Code of Conduct

- Reservation Policy: Transportation is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Passholders may reserve up to two trips per month, subject to calendar availability.
 - Requests **must** be made at least 2 weeks before your event date.
 - Pickup and return times cannot be changed within 48 hours of your trip.
 - Transportation is not confirmed until you receive a callback from the Arts Access Office.
- Cancellation Policy: Advanced notice of a minimum of 48 hours is required for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation priviledges being suspended.
- **Sanitation Policy:** To maintain cleanliness and safety, please refrain from eating, drinking, or smoking in the vehicle.
- **Accompanied Minors:** Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. If a child requires a car seat, you are responsible for providing and installing it in the vehicle.
- **Passholder Presence:** The passholder who made the transportation request must be present for the trip.
- **Safety Measures:** Always wear a seatbelt. Refrain from distracting behavior. Services animals only.
- **Courtesy and Respect:** Please be courteous to those making reservations and driving the vehicles. Have pickup times and locations ready for your driver.

Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in the termination of transportation privileges.

Additional Considerations

Arts Access Renewal Process:

Your arts access membership is valid for one year from the date of application. The expiration date will be written on your pass. You will receive a renewal notice via email before the expiration date.

You will need to **reapply** for arts access on an annual basis to verify that you are still eligible for the program. You can renew your membership online through our website, by mail, or in person at our office.

Return Visits:

Arts Access passes can only be used once per month at each partner location.

Cancellation Policies:

- Venue Reservations: If you reserve tickets and cannot pick them up or use them, please call and tell the box office or main office as soon as possible.
- Transportation Reservations: Advanced notice of a minimum of 48 hours is required for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended.
- Arts Access Lottery: The tickets reserved for the Arts Access Lottery are purchased by Arts Services Inc. specifically for you! These tickets are NOT donated. If you cannot attend, please notify the Arts Access team as soon as possible so we can transfer the tickets to another passholder.
